The **One AWWA Operator Scholarship** is funded through the support of AWWA's Water Equation and the South Dakota Section AWWA.

PURPOSE of AWARD

AWWA's Water Equation and the South Dakota Section, will award the **One AWWA Operator Scholarship** in the amount of up to \$1000.00 to individuals for Water Operator training and education. Depending on requests, the Section reserves the right to award more than one scholarship in smaller amounts (still totaling \$1000.00 for the year).

Scholarship award funds can be used for certification/licensure, two- or four-year water related associate (or other) degree, technical school program, professional training program, books and manuals, and operator related conferences.

Each scholarship recipient will receive a complimentary one-year AWWA Operator membership.

ELIGIBILITY/GUIDELINES

- Applicant must be a current water operator or seeking to enter the water operator profession.
- Applicant must be pursuing an Operator's License or Certification, two or four-year degree related to the water operator profession, or professional development.
- If applicable, disbursement of the funds will be made directly by the Section to the financial office of recipient's college, university, or technical school.
- Items related to books, manuals, conferences, professional development courses, and other eligible expenses will be reimbursed to recipient upon presentation of eligible receipts.
- Applicant must reside or work within the geographical boundaries of South Dakota.
- Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name and scholarship story for purpose of promotion.
- Preference will be given to applicants from small systems.

APPLICATION PROCESS: DEADLINE/SELECTION/PRESENTATION

The following is needed in order to apply for this scholarship:

- A completed One AWWA Operator Scholarship application which includes the following:
 - o A write-up of applicant's current job duties.
 - o A short paragraph on plans for use of the scholarship funds.
- The applicant must be a US citizen and reside or work within the State of South Dakota.
